To the People of My Practice (my patients):

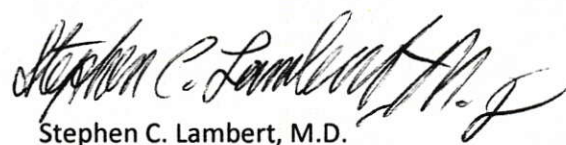
